	Brian Head Town	Brian Head Town will use CDBG funds to purchase a Water Tender for the Fire Department to support fire suppression needs in the town.	\$144,000
	Cedar City on behalf of Cedar City Housing Authority	CDBG funds will be used to acquire 1-2 low-income housing units. All units will be occupied by low- and moderate-income individuals or families in accordance with HUD income limits.	\$175,000
	Cedar City on behalf of Turn Community Services	CDBG funds will be used for energy efficiency at Turn Community Services facilities for persons with disabilities by installing new HVAC, ducting, and air conditioning at a residential facility and new windows at a facility which provides daytime programs.	\$70,400
	Cedar City on behalf of Youthfutures	CDBG funds will be used to serve unhoused youth by developing an outdoor recreation area, removing hazardous trees, and pave a parking lot to support clients and staff at the Youthfutures facility in Cedar City.	\$71,280
	Henrieville Town	CDBG funds will be used for the purchase and installation of new playground equipment at the Henrieville Town park.	\$185,581
	Milford City on behalf of Beaver Housing Authority	Beaver Housing Authority acquisition of land for the construction of up to 12 units. All units will be occupied by low- and moderate-income individuals or families in accordance with HUD income limits.	\$90,000
	Panguitch City	Panguitch City will use CDBG funds to purchase a 2021 1050-Pierce-Custom Enforcer PUC, which will replace an existing pumper truck.	\$200,000
