The following recommendation of the Utah Professional Practices Advisory Commission (UPPAC) is transmitted for action by the Utah State Board of Education:

(1) Case No. 13-1144

The Commission recommends acceptance of the stipulated agreement for suspension of the educator's Level 2 Speech/Language Pathologist Educator License in UPPAC Case No. 13-1144. The educator may request a reinstatement hearing following satisfaction of all conditions in the stipulated agreement and completion of a criminal background check, no sooner than two (2) years from the date of Board action. Any UPPAC recommendation for reinstatement following a hearing is subject to Board approval.

(2) Case No. 13-1118

The Commission recommends revocation of the educator's Level 2 Elementary Education License in UPPAC Case No. 13-1118. Under U.C.A. 53A-6-501(2)(a)(i), the Utah State Board of Education must permanently revoke the educator license of an educator who is convicted of a sexual offense against a minor.
