REQUEST:	AN ORDINANCE OF THE SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT THE SOUTH SALT LAKE STRATEGIC MOBILITY PLAN
APPLICANT:	SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY

MEMO:

The proposed ordinance is to adopt the South Salt Lake Strategic Mobility Plan. This plan works in concert with the South Salt Lake General Plan and guides the City in making decisions regarding all forms of transportation within the City.

Prior to adoption of the 2021 General Plan, South Salt Lake City worked with the Wasatch Front Regional Council (WFRC) and AECOM, a private consulting firm, to develop and write the Strategic Mobility Plan.

The draft Strategic Mobility Plan was used as the foundational basis for drafting the Transportation Element of the new General Plan adopted by the City last August.

The Strategic Mobility Plan includes chapters discussing the existing transportation network, safety, access and demand, physical mobility and network enhancements, health and environment, and community focus.

The proposed Strategic Mobility Plan is intended to guide transportation and mobility decisions for the next 10 years.

During their regular meeting on March 17, 2022, the South Salt Lake City Planning Commission voted unanimously to forward a recommendation that the City Council approve the Strategic Mobility Plan.
