

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT THE SOUTH SALT LAKE STRATEGIC MOBILITY PLAN

WHEREAS, The State of Utah requires that all “municipalit[ies] shall prepare and adopt a comprehensive, long-range general plan for:

- (a) present and future needs of the municipality; and
- (b) growth and development of all or any part of the land within the municipality.”

(see Utah Code § 10-9a-401); and

WHEREAS, South Salt Lake City last adopted a General Plan in August 2021; and

WHEREAS, The State of Utah allows for the general plan to provide for:

- (a) health, general welfare, safety, energy conservation, **transportation**, prosperity, civic activities, aesthetics, and recreational, educational, and cultural opportunities (emphasis added); and

WHEREAS, Prior to adoption of the 2021 General Plan, South Salt Lake City worked with the Wasatch Front Regional Council (WFRC) and AECOM, a private consulting firm, to develop and write the Strategic Mobility Plan; and

WHEREAS, The draft Strategic Mobility Plan was used as the foundational basis for drafting the Transportation Element of the new General Plan; and

WHEREAS, AECOM and South Salt Lake City Staff created an advisory committee and other working groups to engage members of the public in the Mobility Plan Process; and

WHEREAS, the resulting Strategic Mobility Plan includes chapters discussing the existing transportation network, safety, access and demand, physical mobility and network enhancements, health and environment, and community focus; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Strategic Mobility Plan will guide transportation and mobility decisions for the next 10 years; and

WHEREAS, the South Salt Lake Planning Commission held a public hearing on the Strategic Mobility Plan on March 17, 2022; and

WHEREAS, On March 17, 2022, the South Salt Lake Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend that the South Salt Lake City Council vote to adopt the proposed Strategic Mobility

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of South Salt Lake as follows:

SECTION I. Adopted Strategic Mobility Plan. Adopt the General Plan as presented in Exhibit A as the South Salt Lake City Strategic Mobility Plan.

SECTION II. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon Mayor's signature and publication, or after fifteen days of transmission to the office of the Mayor if neither approved nor disapproved by the Mayor, and thereafter, publication.
