

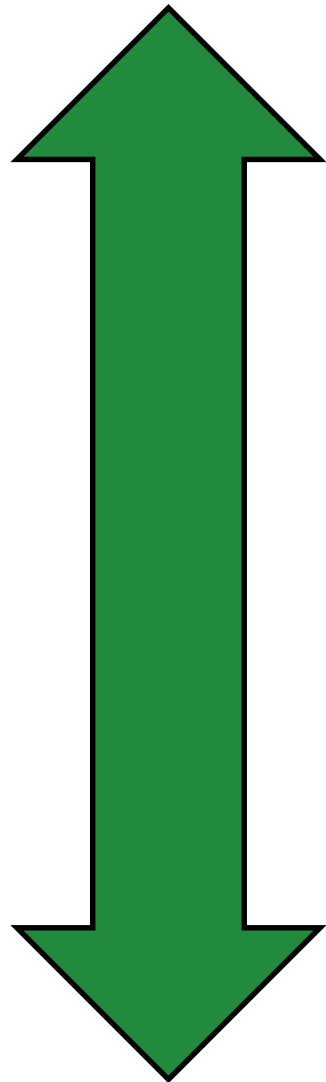
Vision Statement
