



First Quarter 2013



Investigations Unit

- Detective Johnson received information related to a business burglary at Connect Wireless. The perpetrator had stolen 3 iPhones and 4 iPads with a combined value of approximately \$4,300. A suspect was identified and taken into custody. A subsequent search warrant resulted in the recovery of all stolen property.
- Detective Ikemiyashiro and Street Crimes Detectives located two wanted fugitives on Carefree Drive. An incident to arrest search resulted in the seizure of 39.5 Methadone pills, 10 grams of methamphetamine, \$1,162 in cash, and miscellaneous drug paraphernalia.
- Detectives Valencia and Lloyd investigated and solved a graffiti/vandalism case that at the Ivory Highlands swimming pool that generated a significant amount of community concern.
- DEU detectives began conducting anti-bullying efforts in all Taylorsville elementary schools.
- Detective Miller executed a search warrant at Calloway Apartments. This resulted in the seizure of 8 grams of methamphetamine, GHB, scales, paraphernalia, and packaging material.
- Detective Miller located a Federal fugitive leaving a residence. An incident to arrest search warrant resulted in the seizure of five (5) firearms including one sniper rifle and an AR15. Methamphetamine, prescription pills, evidence of distribution and \$3,643 were also located and seized.

Investigations Unit

- On 8/22/2013, the Taylorsville Investigations Unit conducted proactive enforcement throughout Taylorsville and surrounding areas. This effort resulted in the arrests for narcotics distribution and narcotics possession (heroin, cocaine, and methamphetamine). Multiple parole fugitive's were apprehended, three (3) stolen vehicles were recovered and multiple weapons, including a sawed-off shotgun were seized.
- Responding to complaints, Detectives Valencia and Lloyd located suspicious individuals in the area of 1300 West Phillips Lane. The two had been loitering and casing residences. Both lied about their identities and neither resided in the area. They were found in possession of stolen property and documents belonging to other people.
- Detective Miller located an occupied stolen vehicle at the Extended Stay Suites. After a brief foot pursuit, the suspect was apprehended and booked into jail.
- After multiple complaints, DEU Detectives were assigned enforcement action on the City's neighborhood dumpster program. Through their efforts, several individuals were cited for theft. Additionally, several officers proactively patrolled affected areas. Positive feedback was received from the neighbors in those same areas.
- Neighborhood Street Crimes Detectives assisted Sgt. Ricketts and patrol in the service of a drug search warrant at 4030 S. 1300 W. Eleven (11) adults were arrested.

Investigations Unit

- Detective Ikemiyashiro conducted an investigation at 4045 S. Clubhouse Dr. #3812. There had been complaints that the occupants were involved with drug activity. Detective Ikemiyashiro observed drug paraphernalia in plain view and obtained a search warrant. A quantity of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia were located. Calloway management was notified and the occupants were evicted. It was determined that many of the people coming and going from the residence were involved in auto thefts and vehicle burglaries.
- Acting on various complaints, Detective Ikemiyashiro conducted an investigation at 5118 Jay Hill Circle. This investigation led to a search warrant which resulted in three (3) arrests as well as seizures of drug paraphernalia, burglary tools and stolen property. The residence was closed to occupancy by the Health Department.

Investigations Unit

- Detective Lloyd located a suspicious male driving slowly through the Dollar Tree parking lot. The male's girlfriend had an outstanding warrant and was found to be in possession of heroin.
- Detective Ikemiyashiro located a male and female smoking heroin in the FYE parking lot. The investigation resulted in two (2) arrests and the seizure of 14 grams of heroin.
- Detective Miller received information regarding the location of an armed fugitive, who had been making threats that he would not go back to prison. The suspect was located at the Extended Stay in Taylorsville. As he left the hotel in a vehicle, Officers deployed spikes to prevent a pursuit. The suspect was taken into custody and was found to be in possession of a handgun and methamphetamine.
- Detective Miller and Neighborhood Street Crimes Detectives were looking for a parole fugitive at the Extended Stay. Contact was made with several individuals at the hotel resulting in the arrest of 10 people for warrants and other drug-related crimes. A stolen vehicle, drug paraphernalia, methamphetamine, heroin and spice were seized. Chief Wyant, Sergeant Allen and Detective Valencia met with the management and suggested possible solutions to the problems occurring there.

Person Crimes

- On July 4, 2013 officers responded to a Car Jacking/Robbery involving a firearm. Officers and Detectives were able to locate the suspect and the firearm. The suspect was charged with theft, theft by receiving, possession of a firearm by a restricted person, and aggravated assault.
- On July 23, 2013 Officers arrested a male that was videotaping patrons of a tanning salon. He was arrested and booked into jail for voyeurism.
- On July 27, 2013 Officers responded to a stabbing. The victim was in critical condition. After numerous interviews, Detectives were able to arrest 4 individuals.
- Detectives continue to investigate a strong arm robbery that occurred at Club DJ's on September 7, 2013. Video was obtained and suspect descriptions released.
- On August 9, 2013 the US Bank was robbed. Detectives worked diligently and were able to arrest an individual that was responsible for numerous robberies throughout Utah and Idaho.
- On August 14, Detectives responded to a sexual assault. Charges were ultimately filed on the suspect for rape, aggravated sexual assault, and sexual abuse of a child.
- On September 20, 2013 the Deseret Credit Union was robbed. On September 27, Detectives located the suspect, obtained a confession and booked the suspect in jail on multiple robbery charges.

Person Crimes

- On September 26, 2013 the manager of Starbucks was depositing money at a night drop box, when she was accosted and robbed. Detectives are still investigating the case.
- On September 27, 2013 Officers were called to a robbery at Key Bank. Following numerous interviews, detectives were able to work with the FBI to obtain a Federal indictment on an individual for the suspect.
