6.0 WATER HAULING

6.1 Water hauling is prohibited for commercial use, including use ~~as-a~~ for short-term rental ~~property~~ properties.

6.2 Unless prohibited by a local municipality or county, water hauling may be deemed an approved water source for residential and recreational properties, ~~if the property can be~~ which ~~have~~ accessed less than 180 days per calendar year.

~~a. A waiver of this requirement may be considered, on a limited case-by-case basis, upon appeal through the Southwest Utah Public Health Department Adjudicative Appeals Process. Any such appeal will be considered in consultation with the appropriate municipality or county.~~

6.3 Any hauled water shall be drawn from a public water system rated “Approved” by the Utah Department of Environmental Quality - Division of Drinking Water; and follow parameters identified in the Department of Environmental Quality - Division of Drinking Water **Guidance for Hauling Drinking Water** document.

6.1 Water hauling is prohibited for commercial use, including use for short-term rental properties.

6.2 Unless prohibited by a local municipality or county, water hauling may be deemed an approved water source for residential and recreational properties which have access less than 180 days per calendar year.

6.3 Any hauled water shall be drawn from a public water system rated “Approved” by the Utah Department of Environmental Quality - Division of Drinking Water; and follow parameters identified in the Department of Environmental Quality - Division of Drinking Water **Guidance for Hauling Drinking Water** document.
