 - More of these people available and do a better job
 - Moving toward using facilities that provide specialists
- Plan to diversify the program by adding in Leadership Adventures as an elective credit
 - These activities will be indoors, service, simulations, etc. for greater diversity.
- 10 OA's a semester and 4 other activities led by LAU on Fridays that OA is not happening.
- Adding an end of year Elevation Youth Summit
- We need a minimum of 15 students to make a location viable for this program.
