

**Minutes of the North Logan City
Redevelopment Agency Meeting
Held on February 2, 2022
At the North Logan City Library, North Logan, Utah**

Buzzy Mullahkhel made a motion to adjourn the City Council meeting and convene to the meeting of the North Logan Redevelopment Agency. Emily Schmidt seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously with Roger Anderson, Buzzy Mullahkhel, Craig Humphreys, Joni Kartchner, and Emily Schmidt voting in favor.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Lyndsay Peterson at 6:45 p.m.

Adoption of Agenda

Craig Humphreys made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Joni Kartchner seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously with Roger Anderson, Buzzy Mullahkhel, Craig Humphreys, Joni Kartchner, and Emily Schmidt voting in favor.

New Business

6:40 Convene as the Redevelopment Agency (RDA) for a Public Hearing to receive public input on a proposed revision to the FY2022 Budget. Following the public hearing, approval of a resolution may be considered to adopt proposed changes to the FY2022 RDA Budget.

Alan Luce explained the various entities within the RDA, and explained a bit of the various functions and processes, and how the funds are to be used, for the benefit of the new City Council members.

Mayor Peterson said the rules she read aloud previously for speaking at a public hearing still apply, and opened the public hearing at 6:48 p.m.

Dave Flandro asked, in terms of the water situation, whether any of these RDA funds and the way they are being allocated, will be used to anticipate some future development needs that handle more or less water concerns for our budget. He said it seems to him that if we are going to have less water; then, as a result we would probably need to be utilizing some funding for storage and other things, which many of the developments are depending on, but we haven't received yet.

As there were no further public comments, Mayor Peterson closed the public hearing at 6:50 p.m.

Mayor Peterson asked Alan to address this, which he did, and explained, including what the RDA funds are only allowed to be used for.

Buzzy Mullahkhel made a motion to approve Resolution 22-01. Roger Anderson seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously with Roger Anderson, Buzzy Mullahkhel, Craig Humphreys, Joni Kartchner, and Emily Schmidt voting in favor.

Craig Humphreys made a motion to adjourn the RDA meeting and return to the regular portion of the City Council meeting. Buzzy Mullahkhel seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously with Roger Anderson, Buzzy Mullahkhel, Craig Humphreys, Joni Kartchner, and Emily Schmidt voting in favor.

The meeting adjourned at 6:52 p.m.
