COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:

Olsen stated that this hearing was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project that was awarded under the 2022 Community Development Block Grant Program. The city has amended its capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds on behalf of the Aspen Village Road Project, 810 E. 200 S., Mt. Pleasant, UT 84647. The Mayor introduced Dave Oxman from the Aspen Village Road Project. The Mayor explained that the application was successful in the regional rating and ranking process and Aspen Village Road Project awarded \$65,980.00. The Mayor explained the project to those in attendance. The Mayor then asked for any comments, questions and concerns from the audience. There were no comments or questions.
