The concept of governing body creates confusion about who runs the day to day affairs of the city or town. This confusion is compounded by the references to “legislative body” in the Utah code. In a traditional form city or town the **legislative** body is the city council of which the mayor is a member and should in most instances be considered synonymous with the term governing body. The **administrative** powers and duties in a city or town, by state statute, belong to the mayor. They are not part of the powers of the governing body as a whole.
