**1. Title: IRON COUNTY, UTAH "LITTLE HORSE VALLEY"  
PRAIRIE DOG MITIGATION CONSERVATION EASEMENT**

**Applicant: Utah Division of Wildlife Resources**

**Description: Utah Division of Wildlife Resources will hold in perpetuity a Conservation Easement on 220 acres of natural land owned in fee title by Iron County, Utah, for the purpose of a mitigation bank for Utah Prairie Dogs.**

**Comments: The Utah Division of Wildlife Resources proposes to establish a 220-acre conservation easement on lands owned by Iron County for the purpose of creating a Prairie Dog mitigation bank. Iron County is party to this negotiation, and supports the action as part of a long-term strategy to prevent listing of the Prairie Dog as a threatened or endangered species. (Ken Sizemore)**

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2. Title: RIGHT-OF-ENTRY 5387, BARSOOM PICTURES
- Applicant: Trust Lands Administration
- Description: ROE 5387 is a Right-of-Entry application to set up a movie set to film a movie project on Trust Lands. Set construction will involve temporary road construction to access the property as well as set construction which will include scaffold type sets depicting structures, buildings, walls, platforms, towers, sand dunes, etc. Movie sets are proposed for the parcels of land identified below. Set construction is proposed from January 1, 2010 through April. The project will involve up to as many as 250 people for case and crew. There will be numerous construction vehicles and equipment as well as filming equipment on site for the project. A cultural resource survey will be completed on all areas proposed for any ground disturbance. Township 41 South, Range 8 West, Section 16: E2, (within); Township 43 South, Range 2 East, Section 1: W2 (within), Section 2 E2 (within), and Section 12: W2 (within).
