THE COMMUNITY RENEWABLE ENERGY BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 22-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF LOW-INCOME PLANNING RESOURCES TO THE AGENCY'S WEBSITE

WHEREAS, the Community Renewable Energy Board ("Board") met in a regular meeting on June 6, 2022 to consider, among other things, posting low-income planning resources to the Community Renewable Energy Agency's ("Agency") website; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-10 previously passed by the Board on August 3, 2021, the Board created the Low-Income Plan Committee to, among other things "research and compile a list of outreach practices, eligibility criteria, policy measures, or other ideas designed to protect low-income customers from possibly harmful bill impacts, if any, or improve access to energy saving measures"; and

WHEREAS, members of the Low-Income Plan Committee compiled publicly available Federal data sources into summary profiles and maps showing estimated numbers of low-income households and estimated average energy burdens for eligible communities, where available; and

WHEREAS, members of the Low-Income Plan Committee collaborated with representatives from Rocky Mountain Power to design a non-confidential ongoing monthly report showing aggregated low-income assistance enrollment and arrearage data (the "Low-Income Data") for participating communities; and

WHEREAS, the Low-Income Plan Committee wishes to disseminate the energy burden maps and community profiles that incorporate the Low-Income Data (collectively, the "Low-Income Planning Resources") through the Agency's publicly-accessible website at Utah100Communities.org; and

WHEREAS, the Low-Income Planning Resources show aggregated data that are all publicly available, non-confidential, and non-personally identifying.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that the Low-Income Planning Resources be published on the Agency's publicly available website.

This Resolution assigned No. 22-05, shall take effect immediately.
