STORM WATER CODE LANGUAGE

 Current Code language limits the Public Works Director to allowing a maximum 35% reduction in the "impervious surface" storm water fees.

- "Exceed the City's storm water development standards, and/or"
- "Reduce the City's downstream costs in providing storm water capacity."
- The proposed action by Council would allow additional (up to 30%) fee reductions through the City Administrator.



CODE LANGUAGE CHANGE - JUNE 2022

"An appeal of a Director's decision may be brought before the City Administrator within (30) days after the date of the Director's decision."

"The City Administrator may request additional information before making a decision. After reviewing the available information, the City Administrator may:

- 1. Uphold the Director's decision, or
- 2. Apply an additional service charge credit not to exceed 65% of the original service charge amount."

"Decision of the City Administrator shall be final and conclusive."



STORM WATER CODE LANGUAGE

4-12-107 SYSTEM OF RATES AND FEES



of real property within the City except governmentally-owned streets and storm sewer facilities operated and maintained by, or for, the Storm Sewer Utility, the County or the State of Utah. The fees shall fund the administration, planning, design, construction, water quality programming, operation, maintenance and repair of the existing and future storm sewer system.
