Andy Gant updated the group on a few different bills that have been going through the house. The first one was the uranium sanctions from Russia that could potentially effect Utah. Andy sent out an email that he had received and forwarded it to the Public Lands Department so that it can be followed up on and implemented into the RMP if needs be.

Mike asked what the price of the yellow cake is and Andy said he wasn't sure but it was about \$30 per ton.

Byard (phone)- Said that they have proposed a bill to permanently withdraw the uranium mine on the strip. He said that if the build back better plan is passed it will be withdrawn. He said that the committee should be in tune with that because it effects our county and residents. Taylor mentioned that he and Clayton would keep up on that information and relay to the group as info is received.

Bart gave an update from Best Friends Animal Sanctuary. He talked about the newly constructed sand cave parking lot. The lot is on the UDOT right-of-way on the turn off to Best Friends south entrance. He wanted to get something in writing for the maintenance of the parking lot to understand who will be taking care of that. Taylor said that the County will get started on an MOU for that. Jeff Stott mentioned he could help get that drafted.

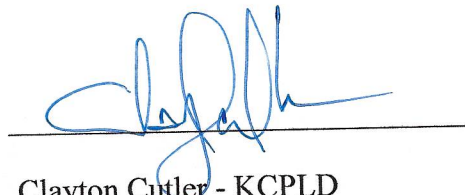
Tony said they are having their ATV jamboree here in April. They may have more than 300 people show up which is a really good group. He will give an update when it concludes.
