BLUFFDALE ARTS ADVISORY BOARD MEETING MINUTES
Tuesday, September 17, 2013

REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING

1. The meeting began at 8:20. Diane Kelley, Laura Garner, Angelle Anderson, Amanda Luker, and Lori Howell were present. Marianne Dunn came at 8:25. Blain Dietrich came at 9:25 after City Council meeting. Adrienne Schmidt was an invited guest and Becky Brockbank was a visitor.

2. **Motion:** Minutes of the regular meeting held July 16, 2013 were read and approved unanimously, with Angelle Anderson moving and Lori Howell seconding, with minor corrections; to wit: Under item 2, paragraph 6, Laura said that she has four or five “long cloaks,” and she also has “lamp tops in the shed, which can be attached to poles made from carpet tubes for an old-fashioned look.”

3. Laura wished to present and discuss next the financial report for the last two musical productions, *42nd Street* and *Music Man*, and had prepared a handout, which is attached. *42nd Street* did not see the audience it should have had and this is attributed to the timing in the first week of August. Laura suggested that the third week would work better, but this will also depend on whether the school is available at that time, the week before school starts. Laura will check.

4. Laura would like to simply use the same production crew as she usually uses for both productions of *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat* in March, and *Thoroughly Modern Millie* next summer. Auditions for the first one will be in December, for the second in May. Laura and Angelle decided not to do the production (a 45-minute comical, non-musical version) of *A Christmas Carol*, even though they have the money. They would need to find a director to do it.

5. Adrienne Schmidt filled the Board in on the status of the Christmas event *Christkindlmarkt*, which has been proposed, and which was presented to the City Council at their last meeting. The attorney has some concerns, specifically that it is a Christmas, and so presumably, a religious event—with manger scenes being sold. At first she couldn't figure out why he thought it was religious. Christkindl is a mythical girl with long blond hair, so it probably won't be a problem. Laura checked the web and found that the city of Chicago sponsors Christkindlmarkt. Adrienne and her family help with the celebrations at *This Is the Place State Park*, who borrowed their idea and started doing *Christkindlmarkt* last year. Laura said that we should proceed with everything, without announcing a location, till we know for sure. A second option would be to hold it at the Lion's Park.

(Lori Howell left at 9:30 p.m.)

General areas of need are: advertising - Amanda; vendor management; entertainment; building booths, costumes and props - Laura; facades and decor - Laura; physical facilities for vendors; entertainment; lighting of the trees; petting zoo - someone needs to check with Quinn Barton, who has a donkey and goats, etc.; take down - everyone. It will be held December 7, 14, and 21st from 2:00 to 6:00 p.m.

6. Marianne's *Battle of the Bands* was discussed. The *Cancer Relay for Life*, holds an event every June on a Friday night, which goes all night long with entertainment and winds up around noon on Saturday, and they would like the BoB to be part of their entertainment; very encouraging for Marianne, who worked very hard on the events. Bruce Kartchner appreciates the Board doing things besides plays.

Diane brought up again the desire to do a talent/variety night and wondered if the BoB could be combined with it. Laura reminded us that we had talked about doing a talent/variety night before *Movies in the Park* each time—about three times per summer. It was suggested later after Blain had arrived that the picnic tables could be removed from under the pavilion to provide a stage for both the BoB and the talent nights. Blain said yes to that. The tables could then be used as seating for audience. It was suggested that the first half hour could be for elementary-age children and then older people after that. It was also suggested that one night could be for comedy, another for karaoke, etc.

7. Becky Brockbank wants to help out and had suggestions. She attends most of the Bluffdale events and has done haunted houses in the past. She suggested that along with *Trunk or Treat* the city could host a haunted house. Diane suggested a party with square dancing and apple-bobbing types of things. Laura suggested story telling. Something to think about for next year.

8. A possible replacement on the Board for Robbi Billman was discussed. Laura talked to her and she wasn't feeling well so didn't come to the meeting but isn't sure she wants to step down. She will think about it for a couple of days. It would need to be advertised in the *Bluffdale Times* before a person can be selected. A person does not have to be an official member of the Board to attend meetings and help out.

9. The next meeting will be held Tuesday, November 12, at 8:00 p.m. at the usual location.
