BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PROGRAM

1984

- Began emission testing gasoline vehicles due to ozone

1996

- Began diesel vehicle emission testing at Kaysville Tech Center

1997

- Began “centralized” gasoline vehicle emission testing at the Tech Center
 - ✦ 1st program in the country to use OBD testing
 - ✦ 1st location in Utah for “one stop shopping”

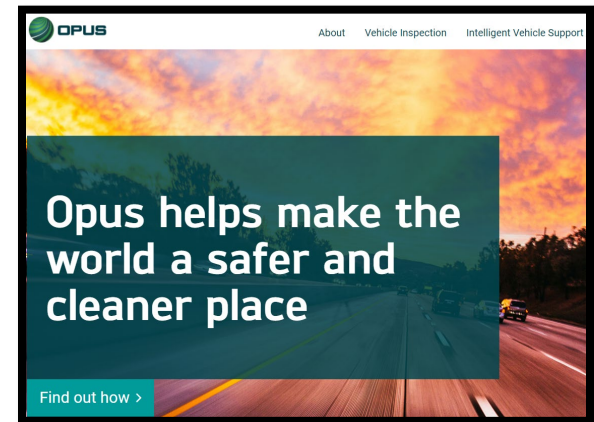
2012

- Closed Tech Center to gasoline emission testing
- Awarded Worldwide Environmental Products two contracts



FUTURE OF THE PROGRAM

- Awarded New Contract Beginning January 1, 2023
 - Opus Inspection
 - ✦ Experienced emission company (30,000 analyzers)
 - ✦ Headquartered in Connecticut
 - ✦ National call center out of Draper, Utah
 - ✦ Currently provide emission services to Utah and Bear River Health Departments
- Enhancements to Our Emissions Program
 - New analyzers
 - ✦ Updated cameras
 - Paperless certificates directly to DMV
 - Improved reporting capabilities
 - Customer service
