



Invitation to Submit Arguments For or Against Cache County Ballot Proposition

The General Election Ballot for the November 8, 2022 election will include an opinion question. The ballot title will read as follows:

“Shall the Cache County, Utah, be authorized to impose a 0.1% sales and use tax for the purpose of funding recreation, arts, parks and zoos in Cache County, Utah?”

Funding may be used for publicly owned or operated facilities such as:

- Parks
- Playing fields
- Trails
- Bike paths
- Performing arts centers
- Museums
- Art galleries

Funding may be used to support non-profit organizations providing programs such as:

- Live theater
- Symphonies
- Operas
- Ballet/Dance
- Choral groups
- Festivals
