A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY COUNCIL  
AUTHORIZING THE SOUTH SALT LAKE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO  
APPROPRIATE BICYCLES IN ITS POSSESSION TO A PUBLIC INTEREST  
USE.

WHEREAS, the South Salt Lake City Police Department (“SSLC PD”) has acquired possession of bicycles as found property or for safekeeping, the list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the SSLC PD is authorized pursuant to state law to dispose of the property after reasonable steps have been taken to determine the identity and location of the owner and after reasonable steps have been taken to notify the owner that the property is in the SSLC PD’s custody;

WHEREAS, the SSLC PD has made reasonable efforts to identify and notify owners of the property, and has either been unsuccessful in determining ownership over the property, or has notified the apparent owner and has not received a response;

WHEREAS, Utah Code permits the City Council to authorize that the lost or mislaid property be applied to a public interest use;

WHEREAS, the City has published notice, the Public Notice of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B, of the potential appropriation of this property, and has provided adequate time for the public to respond to the notice;

WHEREAS, Free Bikes 4 Kidz is a nonprofit charity registered with the State; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the bicycles could be put to public interest use by donating the bicycles to Free Bikes 4 Kidz,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of South Salt Lake that, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §77-24a-5, the property identified and attached hereto as Exhibit A, may be appropriated for public interest use by donation to Free Bikes 4 Kidz, a nonprofit Charity registered with the State.
