




PARKS, ARTS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL (PARC) COMMITTEE

Payson City is now accepting applications for those interested to serve on the Parks, Arts, Recreation, and Cultural (PARC) Committee. In 2016, 62% of the Payson City voters approved a 1/10 of 1% (0.1%) increase in the local sales and use tax as a means of enhancing funding for local recreational facilities and cultural organizations within Payson City.

The PARC Committee shall review all proposed projects and all mini grants and provide the City Council with recommendations on projects, needs, suggested funding areas, recommended grants, needed facilities, etc. The City Council will give heavy consideration to the recommendations and make the final determination in distributing the PARC funds.

Those interested can visit paysonutah.org or the city offices to obtain an application. Applications must be submitted to the Payson City Recorder no later than 6:00 p.m. on September 6, 2022.
