1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Mayor Woolstenhulme Opened the meeting and led the Council and others in the Pledge of Allegiance. **Councilmember Neff** offered the invocation.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT FOR ITEMS NOT LISTED ON THE AGENDA: NONE

3. PRESENTATION: COUNTY PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT, DEREK SIDDOWAY, COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTOR SUMMIT COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND TYLER ORGILL, SUMMIT COUNTY EVENT MANAGER

Mr. Siddoway introduced himself and Mr. Orgill to the County and presented the Council with several initiatives the County is undertaking to improve communications to County residents. They highlighted a new alert system that allows residents to scan a QR code and then become enrolled to receive critical alerts & information for emergency situations via home, business, cell phone, email, or text. These emergency messages are also available in Spanish but require a numeric text to enroll in the system. The County Council will continue to stream all their meetings live on Facebook or Zoom for public viewing and a weekly podcast available on Apple and Spotify titled summit6.org will summarize the most up-to-date news and happenings. They are asking the City to publish a flier on the City website as well as on bulletin boards and social media to promote the initiatives.

42 instructed City Staff to follow through with the requests for publication of the fliers.

45 **Mayor Woolstenhulme** stated that in reviewing the existing committee ordinance with City
46 legal counsel, the ordinance is effectual in allowing the Council to create committees as
47 discussed in previous Council meetings, and that the powers and duties included in the existing
48 ordinance are sufficient for the purposes of committee organization and administration. The
49 issue is not that the ordinance needs to be revised but adhered to.
