# **Moab Valley Fire Protection District Commission Meeting**

**October 18th, 2022-4:00 PM**

## **A. Call to Order:**

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Archie Walker at 4:03 p.m.
2. Commissioners Present: Chairman Archie Walker, Commissioner Jim McGann, Commissioner Charlie Harrison
3. Staff Present: Chief T.J. Brewer, Fire Inspector Brandon McGuffee, Administrator Cathy Bonde
4. Others Present: Traedyn Brewer, Trena Harrison

## **B. Citizens to Be Heard:** None present wishing to speak.

## **C. General Business:**

1. Commissioner Harrison motioned to approve minutes from the September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner McGann and passed unanimously.
2. Commissioner Harrison motioned to approve bills, Commissioner McGann seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

## **D. Chief's Report:**

1. Chief Brewer reported there were 26 calls to service since the last Commission meeting.
2. Chief Brewer informed the Commission that multiple meetings and drills have been recently attended. This includes a meeting with leaders from the fire service community who were selected to rewrite the NFPA 1403 code which directs us on live fire training. Other notable meetings include the local radio task force meeting and Certification Council Board meeting. Numerous meetings have taken place within the Department, and Fire drills have been performed at multiple schools.
3. Chief Brewer and Cathy continue to work on fine tuning the proposed 2023 budget.
4. The process of training the Spanish Valley crew has begun. The started with four members and are down to two.

5. The new radios have been programmed. We plan to do a training with firefighters before they are put into service.
6. Emergency Coordinator Shea Walker is currently working on a grant using ARPA funds allocated by legislation for more radios. We still need mobiles for the engines and several more handhelds.
7. The committee reviewing our policies has concluded the initial process. Chief Brewer will be approving and implementing these policies over the next few months.
8. Moab Fire is teaming with Red Cross to do a Sound the Alarm program. This program will be a push through social media and will be getting us out into the community distributing and installing smoke/CO alarms.
9. We will begin using ISPY which is a CAD based system that allows us to see the information dispatch is receiving from a 911 caller as well as what the dispatcher is recording for the incident. There are other features of the system that will be valuable to us. EMS has purchased the first year subscription and is allowing us to access through their subscription. This gives us the opportunity to use the system on a trial basis before deciding to purchase a separate subscription.
10. Fire prevention education is currently taking place. We are visiting schools and having classes visit the Fire Station. Children are learning valuable fire safety information taught by Brandon McGuffee, Sparky, and other staff and volunteers. This program has become more time intensive than in the past.
11. Moab Fire is currently heading up a push to create a multi-agency water rescue team. This team will include members across emergency response agencies in our community. The focus is to combine the Dive team and Search and Rescue groups that respond to water emergencies so they will be under one umbrella. This would include a swift-water rescue team. By having these responders under one umbrella, it will ease the burden of just one department funding the teams, and it will be easier to maintain staffing.
12. Moab Fire is hosting a multi-agency Mass Casualty Incident training on October 19<sup>th</sup> at the aquatic center beginning at 6:30 p.m.
13. Instructors from Utah Fire and Rescue Academy will be teaching an advanced extrication class on October 26<sup>th</sup> at Station 3. The class will last approximately 8 hours. A large number of volunteers have committed to this training.

#### **E. Old Business:**

1. Annexation – Chief Brewer informed the Commissioners that another meeting with Pathway Associates will be taking place soon.
2. Emergency Coordinator Contract – Chief Brewer stated that EMS continues to be on board with maintaining this position.
3. Horizon Movie Briefing – Chief Brewer informed the Commission that the District is currently sending 2 personnel and an engine to the movie set Monday through Friday, and this is expected to continue for a couple more weeks.
4. Fraud Risk Assessment – Cathy informed the Commission the 2022 Fraud Risk Assessment approved by the Commission has been filed with the State Auditor.

5. 2022 Amended Budget – Cathy went over changes made to the proposed 2022 amended budget since the prior meeting and stated she anticipates some other changes before sending the budget to public hearing in December.
6. 2023 Draft Budget – The proposed budget for 2023 without expansion was presented as balanced. The proposed 2023 budget with expansion was presented with additional expenses as to costs expected to be incurred with the expansion. Chief Brewer went over the rationale for additional expenses. Chief Brewer also presented the Commissions with a worksheet from the National Volunteer Fire Council that calculates the savings to taxpayers by functioning as a volunteer department.

**F. New Business:**

1. Mutual Aid Agreement-CNY – Chief Brewer presented the Mutual Aid Agreement with Canyonlands Regional Airport for signature by Chairman Walker.

**G. Closed Session:**

1. Chairman Walker motioned to enter closed session to discuss professional competence and personnel issues at 5:10 p.m. Commissioner Harrison seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
2. Commissioner McGann motioned to exit closed session at 5:30 p.m. Commissioner Harrison seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
