**1. Comments from the public.**

Ric Ramirez lives in Rivershadow Estates. The traffic at the intersection of Indian Springs Drive and Washington Fields Road is extremely dangerous.

Councilman Turek commented the Industrial Road light is going to help because it will create breaks in the traffic flow. We are pushing to get it installed as soon as possible.

Mr. Ramirez suggested putting up signs to reduce the traffic speed on the intersection at the curve where he is speaking.

Councilman Turek explained the sign is something they could try, but in past experience people tend to ignore signs. It may have to be Indian Springs Subdivision become a right in and right out only. He will speak with Public Works Director Mike Shaw to get some different alternatives.

Mayor Neilson read a letter from a 10 year old boy who would like some things done in the park by the church. He read the letter, and will be bringing the suggestions to Leisure Services Director Barry Blake.

Councilman Turek stated he knows Barry Blake has been working on revitalizing Veterans Park. However, he is not sure where our insurance stands on the swings or slide.

Councilman Seegmiller stated he feels it would be nice for the young man to receive a letter back in response to his suggestions.
