Docket No. 2022-025 Cause No. 132-06 – In the matter of the Request for Agency Action of OVINTIV USA INC. for an order vacating the order entered in Cause No. 139-99 and instead pooling all interests, including the compulsory pooling of the interests of certain non-consenting owners in the Nooh Tuh Vweep wells, in the drilling unit established for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Lower Green River-Wasatch Formations comprised of all of Sections 16 and 21, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, U.S.M., Duchesne County, Utah.
