Regular Work Meeting Minutes November 16, 2022, at 6:00 pm 212 N. Toquer Blvd, Toquerville Utah

#### A. CALL TO ORDER:

Councilman Sip called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Campbell and the Opening Prayer was said by Councilman Chaves.

### **B.** APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

# **E: BUSINESS:**

1. Interview candidates to fill the vacancy on City Council.

Council interviewed candidates in the order the applications were received.

#### **Todd Sands**

Todd doesn't have any direct experience on a city council, but he has experience in city government. He worked for a first responder agency and has had a lot of interaction with the mayor and council. He can help make decisions and solve problems. He believes the three biggest issues are communication, the ordinances and regulation updates. His three goals for Toquerville would be manage development, make sure our public safety impact fees are showing what the costs are going to be for the city and keeping resident taxes low. Since he has moved here, he has missed about 2 city council meetings, and the last couple of months he has been coming to the planning commission meetings. He volunteered at the July Independence Day activities. Todd believes his greatest accomplishment besides his family is making it 35 years as a first responder and being retired here in Toquerville. He believes that all the candidates would be a good council member.

## Wayne Olsen

Wayne has been a councilmember before and is currently serving on the planning commission. He's had a lot of experience with governments. He believes the three issues are, growth, character of this town, and budget. The goals he has are preserving the character of the town and keeping it rural. He is on the planning commission and has been to most all the city councils. He is currently volunteering on the planning commission and has done much more. Wayne believes his greatest achievement other than his family is being alive. He believes any of them would be great on the city council.

## **Angela Harrison**

Angela has three basic qualifications. She loves Toquerville, she has been real estate agent for the last 16 years and is heavily involved with the community because of that. She also has a skill in negotiation and public relations. She has been a state delegate, a county delegate, and is now serving as precinct chair for Toquerville and is also a member of the county CCC community. Three issues that she sees with Toquerville is growth, prosperity, and safety. Her goals would be to assist the city with those issues. She has attended 3 meetings this year. Her main community service would be with the Miss Toquerville Pageant and the for 3-4 years she was the judge's chairman. She has also done small things like overseeing the pioneer day parade and three of her sons have done their eagle scouts projects in Toquerville. Angela believes her greatest accomplishment other than her family would be being a small business owner. Angela believes she would be a better choice because she is a strong powerful woman who loves Toquerville.

Mayor Sip commented that Cory turner is also a nominee but was unable to get work off to be at this meeting. There will be five open positions on the council next year so all those who wish to run are encouraged.
