

MINUTES
OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF EQUALIZATION OF TOOELE COUNTY
HELD SEPTEMBER 27, 2022

Chairman Tripp called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM. The time, place and agenda of the meeting had been provided to the Tooele Transcript Bulletin and to each member of the governing body by posting the notice and agenda at least two days before on the Tooele County website and emailing them a link.

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL.

Present at the meeting were Council Members Tom Tripp, Chair, Kendall Thomas, Scott Wardle, Tye Hoffmann, and Jared Hamner.

Also present were Andy Welch, County Manager, Brittany Lopez, Assistant to the County Manager, Tracy Shaw, Clerk and Alison McCoy, Auditor.

2. APPROVAL OF AUGUST 2, 2022, MINUTES

A) AUGUST 2, 2022

Council Member Tripp suggested a change to item 3 paragraph B. Amend to say, "the court order related to pipeline caused about a third of the parcels that were adjusted."

Council Member Thomas makes motion to approve with Council Member Tripp's amendment. Second by Council Member Hoffmann. All in favor.

Council Member Hoffmann abstains from vote.

3. REVIEW OF INDIGENT APPLICATIONS

A) ABATEMENTS FOR REVIEW

Council Member Tripp explained the abatement program and the eligibility requirements. He stated that the County Manager made some recommendations to deny some and approve.

Council Member Tripp stated that there are seven that he feels should not be approved as they do not include any documentation that shows disability or explains any hardship. Only proof of income was provided. He feels that additional information should be required.

Council Member Wardle asked if the managers list could be amended to remove the requests that will not be recommended.

Council Member Tripp stated he would approve the managers list as recommended except those that need additional information.

Alison McCoy, Auditor, advised that the Auditors Office is trying to get these approved or denied in time for tax notices. She requested that the Council specify of deadline of when additional information must be submitted. The Treasurer will be sending out tax information within the next few weeks.

Council Member Wardle went over line numbers that will be denied.

Council Member Wardle made a motion to approve as recommended by the County Manager with the exception of numbers 40, 37, 32, 7, 19, 39, allowing those individuals time to provide additional documentation before the second meeting in

October. If no information is provided by then, the requests will be considered denied.
Second by Council Member Hoffmann. All in favor. The motion passed.

Auditor McCoy stated that the next Board of Equalization meeting will be on October 18, 2022.

4. NOTICE OF CORRECTION

A) ASSESSOR CORRECTION —1

Council Member Tripp explained there was a technical glitch when this amendment was filed. Jake Parkinson, Assessor requested an adjustment. Council Member Tripp questions if there are other glitches that haven't come forward.

Council Member Hoffmann made a motion to approve, second by Council Member Hamner. All in favor. The motion passed.

5. ADJOURN

Council Member Hamner made a motion to adjourn, second by Council Member Hoffmann. All in favor. Time of adjournment was 4:15pm.
