¹ = Green/yard waste loads containing inorganic materials and other contaminants will be charged at the construction and demolition debris rate. Root balls interbedded with dirt and rocks do not constitute recoverable green waste, cannot be compacted, and will be charged at the concrete and asphalt rate.

² = Construction and demolition debris loads containing concrete and/or asphalt will be charged at the concrete and asphalt rate.

³ = Scrap metal must be free of other debris and materials. Old lawn mowers and other equipment are accepted as long as all fluids have been removed/drained. Non-freon containing appliances are accepted as long as they do not contain polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs). Freon-containing appliances are accepted at the Canyonlands Transfer Station located at 2295 South Highway 191. Scrap metal is containerized and relocated to the Canyonlands Transfer Station for processing and storage prior to reclamation, and, consequently, is accepted for free at the transfer station.

⁴ = Clean fill dirt must be free of organic material and other debris, including but not limited to tree limbs, grasses, large rocks, and boulders. Dirt containing organic material and other debris will be charged at the construction and demolition debris rate. Projects with large volumes of clean fill are assessed an equipment usage fee after 120 cubic yards of clean fill and for every 120 cubic yards thereafter.

⁵ = Tires and bulk loads of tires with rims are charged 1.5 times the applicable per unit fee above.

⁶ = Acceptance of materials beyond regular hours of operations will be considered for large commercial projects and must be approved in advance by Authority administrative staff. The after hours fee is billed in 15-minute increments (i.e., \$30 per quarter hour) with a one-hour minimum charge of \$120.

The Moab Landfill is permitted to accept certain types of construction and demolition debris, which restricts most furniture and mattresses from disposal at the facility. Due to ongoing requests and for the convenience of our residential¹ customers, the Moab Landfill is now accepting the following items that will be rerouted to the Klondike Landfill for disposal. These items will need to be offloaded to a separate staging area as directed by Solid Waste Authority staff and will be charged as indicated below.

¹ This bulky waste diversion program is intended for RESIDENTS ONLY. Commercial loads and large quantities of bulky waste materials, including furniture from overnight accommodations and other rentals, are generally NOT accepted and will be charged two-times the above-listed rates. Commercial-derived bulky waste items should be delivered directly to the Canyonlands Transfer Station to qualify for the above-listed rates.

² Oversized furniture exceeding four (4) cubic yards of total airspace will be charged the oversized furniture rate plus \$5 per each additional cubic yard per item.

- Bulky items for curbside pickup must be prepositioned in an accessible location outside of all buildings and structures. Solid Waste Authority staff will not enter any buildings or structures to retrieve items scheduled for bulky waste pickup.
- Items containing freon (e.g., refrigerators, air conditioners) are NOT accepted at the Moab Landfill under this program. Freon-containing appliances are accepted at the Canyonlands Transfer Station. The Solid Waste Authority may consider curbside pickup of these items for delivery to the Canyonlands Transfer Station if arranged in advance.
- Canyonlands Solid Waste Authority reserves the right to reject bulky waste items scheduled for curbside pickup and for diversion at the Moab Landfill based on the condition(s) of the bulky waste item(s).

⁴ = Must be declared prior to or at delivery. Special handling fee of \$20 per large animal carcass (e.g., horse, cow, elk, camel, zebra).

² = Green/yard waste loads containing inorganic materials and other contaminants will be charged at the construction and demolition debris rate. Tree trunks, root balls, and other bulky green/yard waste items are NOT accepted and must be delivered to the Moab Landfill for disposal and/or reclamation.

³ = Construction and demolition debris loads containing concrete, asphalt, rocks, dirt, sand, and/or boulders are NOT accepted at the Canyonlands Transfer Station. These heavy weight items must be delivered to the Moab Landfill for disposal and/or reclamation.

⁴ = Metals must be free of other debris and materials or will be charged at the construction and demolition debris rate. Old lawn mowers and other equipment are accepted as long as all fluids have been removed/drained. Materials containing polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) are strictly prohibited.

⁵ = Tires and bulk loads of tires with rims are charged 1.5 times the applicable per unit fee above. Tires are containerized and relocated to the Moab Landfill for storage prior to recycling/reclamation and, consequently, are accepted at the Moab Landfill for 50% of the Transfer Station price. Heavy equipment tires are NOT accepted at the Transfer Station and must be delivered to the Moab Landfill.

- * Cardboard hauls containing large amounts of debris/trash will be charged the MSW & C&D haul rate.
