



Second Quarter 2013



Investigations Unit

- On 10/4/2013, Taylorsville Detectives learned the location of a wanted fugitive. After confirming that the suspect was inside of the residence, containment was established. After several challenges and the dispatch of a K9 Unit, the suspect surrendered.
- On 10/08/13, Detective Miller located an occupied stolen vehicle leaving the Extended Stay Hotel. A high-hazard stop was conducted and three (3) individuals were detained. A small quantity of methamphetamine was located. Two of the individuals were booked into jail for charges and outstanding warrants.
- On 10/14/13, Detective Miller observed an occupied stolen vehicle pull into the driveway of a Taylorsville residence. A high-hazard stop was conducted and the occupant was determined to be a Federal fugitive. Another individual at the residence was found to have a warrant for a probation violation.
- On 10/17/2013, Detective Miller located a suspected drug offender in the Walmart parking lot. He followed the vehicle to an apartment complex in Midvale where he initiated a traffic stop. The suspect was ordered to exit his car but refused to comply. Officers breached a window of the car and used a Taser to subdue him. Drug paraphernalia, ammunition, and "bath salts" were located inside the car.

Investigations Unit

- On 10/19/13, DEU detectives helped coordinate a neighborhood watch meeting that was held at the LDS church located at 4986 S. Valois Dr. The meeting was well-attended by the community.
- On 10/21/2013, Detective Lloyd observed a suspicious vehicle near a strip mall. Upon closer examination, Detective Lloyd noticed garden hoses attached to exhaust pipes extending into the car window. The victim was attempting suicide, but was unsuccessful because of Detective Lloyd's actions.
- On 10/22/2013, Detective Lloyd was in the process of conducting a hit and run investigation that occurred in Taylorsville, when he observed the suspect. After a brief pursuit, the driver yielded and was taken into custody. The suspect had several outstanding arrest warrants and was in possession of spice.
- On 10/23/2013, Sergeant Allen attempted to conduct a traffic stop of a vehicle for a traffic violation. The vehicle fled and was followed from a distance by officers from other agencies. WVCPD initiated a pursuit out of Magna. The driver crashed through a fence and abandoned his vehicle at CR England in WVC. A loaded handgun was found under the driver's seat. Detective Jaren Fowler located the suspect the following night during a traffic stop at 3900 South State Street.

Investigations Unit

- On 10/24/2013, Detective Ikemiyashiro provided information on a serial robbery suspect. Investigations Unit Detectives made contact with several different units at Casa Linda Apartments. As a result of the activities, leads were generated that assisted in the identification and apprehension of a Federal Fugitive, who confessed to five business robberies.
- On 10/25/2013, Detective Miller had probable cause to believe that the driver of a Mazda 6 had committed several residential burglaries. He attempted to stop the suspect vehicle but the driver fled from him. He pursued the car for a short distance. A UHP helicopter followed the car to Kearns where it was spiked by Officer Twohill. The driver was taken into custody. In addition to the aforementioned charges, the driver also had outstanding arrest warrants and was an escapee from UPD Drug Court.
- On 10/25/2013, Detective Denise Ikemiyashiro located an occupied stolen vehicle eastbound on 4500 South. She was able to stop the vehicle and take three males into custody. Methamphetamine, scales, and packaging material were located in the vehicle.
- On 10/31/2013, Detective Ikemiyashiro observed individuals using drugs at a parking lot inside of a vehicle. The two individuals were arrested. Heroin and drug paraphernalia were seized at the scene.

Investigations Unit

- On 11/07/2013, Detective Ikemiyashiro apprehended an individual who was in possession of 28 balloons of heroin and \$935.00 in U.S. Currency
- On 11/12/2013, Detectives Lloyd and Ikemiyashiro located an occupied stolen vehicle. The vehicle fled when Officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop. After a brief pursuit the driver was apprehended by Detective Lloyd. The adult male driver was also in possession of methamphetamine.
- On 11/12/2013, Officers were dispatched on suspicious males attempting to burglarize a residence in Taylorsville. Detective Johnson located a vehicle leaving the area and conducted a traffic stop. Detective Johnson located suspected stolen property inside the car. This investigation and subsequent arrests led to closure on two additional Taylorsville residential burglaries.
- On 11/12/2013, Detective Lloyd conducted a traffic stop. The passenger was non-compliant. Detective Ikemiyashiro arrived to assist. While the passenger was being searched by Detective Lloyd he became physically combative. The suspect was subdued by Detective Ikemiyashiro utilizing a Taser.

Investigations Unit

- On 11/14/2013, an armed robbery occurred at 3871 West 5400 South. The suspect vehicle was located by UPD Dispatcher Sharpe who was riding with Sergeant Paul Barker. Officers attempted contact at 5625 S. 4015 W. #A. After a search warrant was executed, evidence of the robbery was located including a sawed off shotgun. Detectives Ikemiyashiro, Fowler, Miller, and Chacon as well as patrol, K9, and the Metro Gang Unit were instrumental in bringing this case to a successful conclusion.
- On 11/15/2013, Detective Miller conducted a traffic stop. The male driver was a documented gang member and had outstanding warrants. The female passenger was arrested for charges. During a search of the vehicle, methamphetamine, a .357 revolver, and forgery items were located and seized.
- On 11/15/2013, Detective Miller apprehended a fugitive in the parking lot of the Extended Stay hotel. Contact was made at the arrestee's room where a wanted female was also discovered. Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia were located in a subsequent search.

Investigations Unit

- On 11/23/2013, NSC and DEU detectives assisted the Metro Gang Unit in a significant drug case. Four vehicles were stopped leaving the target residence. A search warrant was then executed at the house. ½ pound of methamphetamine, one ounce of heroin, \$3,000 cash, an AK47 assault rifle and a stolen vehicle were recovered.
- On 11/23/2013, Detective Ikemiyashiro and Officer Sanderson conducted a traffic stop. 6 balloons of heroin and two balloons of cocaine were found in the vehicle. Two adult females were arrested.
- On 12/18/2013, Detective Fowler located an occupied stolen vehicle at the Extended Stay Hotel. The female occupant was detained. Contact was made at her room and another person was detained. Heroin, marijuana, and paraphernalia were located in the room.
- On 12/26/2013, Detective Miller located a reckless driver going westbound at 4100 South Redwood Road. He attempted to stop the vehicle but the driver failed to yield. A low speed pursuit was initiated. It appeared that the driver was intoxicated. The driver struck another vehicle at 2700 West 4100 South and was taken into custody by Detective Miller.

Investigations Unit

- On 12/27/2013, Detective Miller located an occupied stolen vehicle in the Walmart parking lot. He attempted to perform a traffic stop but the vehicle fled eastbound. A pursuit was not initiated. Detectives located the vehicle in the Smith's parking lot located at 700 West 5300 South. The female passenger was immediately located and detained. The driver was located in the store and fled on foot from detectives. Detective Fowler apprehended the male outside of the store.
- Metro Gang Unit (MGU) Sergeant Bell followed a vehicle that left an address MGU was watching for two fugitives. A traffic stop was conducted at 4100 South Redwood Road for a traffic violation. A Crip gang member from California, was detained for a warrant. 1 gram of meth was recovered that he had just purchased from one of the primary targets. Charged with Felony POCS.

Person Crimes

- 71 criminal cases ranging from Assault, Domestic Violence, Domestic Violence in the presence of children and Protective Order violations.
- On 10/11/13, Detective Arnold responded to a physical child abuse that occurred in Taylorsville. The 3 year old male victim presented with obvious inflicted trauma to his buttocks, legs, back, and face. Through our investigation we found the mother's boyfriend was the perpetrator of the injuries. The District Attorney's Office filed Felony Child Abuse.
- Detective Martinez is currently investigating a sexual battery case that occurred in June, but not reported until December.
