4. UPDATE ON THE APPLICATION TO PUT THE DITCHES AND THE ROCKVILLE HISTORIC DISTRICT ON THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES
Kirk Huffaker, the consultant who is writing the nomination, sent a map of Rockville Historic District's proposed boundary for review. Commission members felt the northern boundary could move south along an irrigation ditch, and the southern boundary should capture more pastures going to the river. Jane will follow up to see if the boundaries can be changed. Jack recommended we talk with UDOT about the nomination.
