Approval of Minutes:

- Carol made a motion to approve the November Golf Advisory Board minutes. Rick seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as written

Follow up to Approved Golf Fees:

- Cart, season pass, senior season pass, range ball bucket fees have been approved.
- Jeff would like the junior/youth fees to be removed and only use the Youth on Course program.

Budget Report:

- Golf course is doing exceptionally well despite the weather. Still doing better than the last few years.
- Dawn explained to Leslee how she works with the City on the financial report in order to keep numbers aligned.
- City funding has been cut back this year, even with that Golf Course doing well.
- Jeff has ordered more golf balls this year than past years.

Driving Range Concept Plan Follow-Up:

- Russ handed out updated plan with suggestions that board members expressed at the last meeting where Dustin Hislop came to present the Driving Range Concept Plan.
- Parking lot was changed to the east side.
- Biggest expenses would be the building and the fence along driving range.
- Fence along with net would save the golf course a large amount of money on golf balls.
- 1200 sq ft building could cost \$350/sq ft. Board members suggested a metal or concrete building.
- Parking stalls were compromised on updated plan causing some concerns.
- Dawn asked if City would do a bond to cover cost of improvements.
- Russ suggested applying for County RAPZ funds to cover project as it falls under Recreation.
- RAPZ funds could be used for engineering costs for building and parking lot.

- Another option would be to try and speak to Mayor and Council members to get this project ahead of other current city projects.
- Jeff mentioned an artificial turf that he thinks would work well to incorporate into the concept plan.
- Tom reminded board members that budget for next fiscal year is being worked on now and these items should be mentioned. Board agrees driving range building project is worth mentioning in this upcoming budget.
- Concept would get rid of sand trap.
- Net would help contain golf balls and some security.

New Tee Signs and Advertising:

- Jeff passed around pictures of current signs and draft of new ones.
- He explained how he personally thought old signs were confusing. New signs look cleaner and better organized.
- Some board members suggested Tee number large up top, Par smaller font underneath.
- Farm Bureau, Pepsi and Top Job are locked in for sponsor signage.
- Board members are welcome to make edits and return to Jeff
- If any board members have any other companies interested in sponsoring a tee sign, please let Jeff know.

Women's Association Report:

- Lindsee would like to schedule a meeting with Jeff to go over some items.
- Brooke Stevenson from Pro Shop will be the vice president, Kaycee is the chair, Maddie is treasurer, Diane will be secretary, historian is Brenda Smith.
- Makenna updated board members that all dues should be paid directly to the treasurer.
- Jeff suggested Women's Association to open a Venmo account to collect fees.

Men's Association Report:

- Nothing as of yet, currently working on schedule for upcoming events.

Golf Superintendent Report:

- Busy grooming cross country ski trails. Jeff showed board members a map of the groomed trail.
- Pumphouse roof is completed
- Working on equipment and goose patrol.

Golf Professional Report:

- Covered most items above.
- Will meet with Men's and Ladies' clubs to go over schedules.
- Will keep off season employees on payroll by requiring them to attend safety trainings. This will save money as rehiring them and having them go through the background check and drug screen process is expensive.
- Busy working on carts and signs.

Other Items:

- Tom will be off the board at the end of this year as he will not run for City Council.
- Rick Johnson's term will be reviewed. Rick would like to extend his term, board approves.
- Carol would like to extend her term as well (expires in August)
