School Programming

All students have a diagnosed hearing loss - many with multiple disabilities

Qualified to attend through an IEP for 504 Process

Follow the Utah State Core and Individualized Education Plans for instruction

Approximately 5 students per class.



Staff: 1 Director, 1 Secretary, 10 teachers, 9 paraprofessionals

Currently 61 students

Pre-ETS and the ACTIVITY CENTER REDESIGN PROJECT

Used to teach a lot of the Pre-ETS skills

Used during the day for classes and at night for residential activities and programming

Collaborate with vocational programs and local businesses to teach employment skills (Work-based learning experiences)

Teach cooking and other independent living skills

Classroom for a variety of subjects

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

Currently 9 students in the cottages

1 Student Life Coordinator and 3 Student Life Technicians

Students must be 14 or older to participate and must exit at age 22



Dorm like dwellings for students that qualify through an IEP process

Focus on teaching independent living skills

Supervised by staff in the evenings and overnight
