Background:

According to the [Utah Every Student Succeeds Act \(ESSA\) Consolidated Plan](#), USBE will identify those schools that have a graduation rate at or below 67% over a three year average as a Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) Graduation Growth (Low Grad) school. [The Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965](#) [As Amended Through P.L. 114–95, Enacted December 10, 2015] Part A, Subpart 1, SEC. 1111. (d)(1)(C)(ii) allows for those schools that are designated as a CSI Graduation Growth (Low Grad) school to forego implementation of improvement activities if their total enrollment is less than 100. The following schools with a total enrollment that is less than 100 have chosen to forego implementation of improvement activities.

- Summit High School, Alpine School District
- Athenian eAcademy Charter School
- Entrada High School, Canyons District
- Youth Educational Support School (YESS), Granite School District
- Pleasant Creek School, North Sanpete School District
- Malan’s Peak Secondary School, Ogden School District
- Cedar Ridge High, Sevier School District
- Horizon Academy, Weber School District
