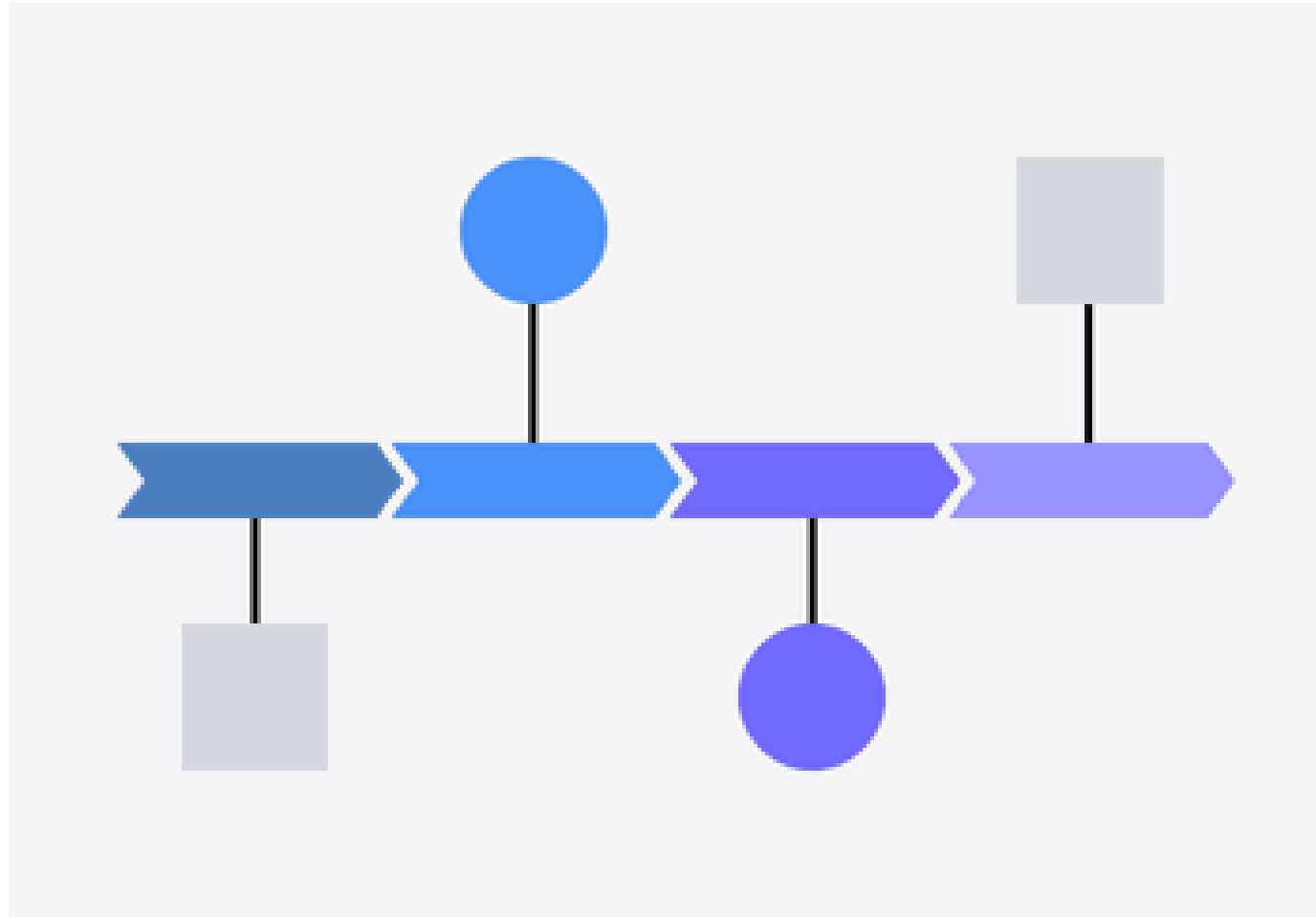


Core Standards Revision Process

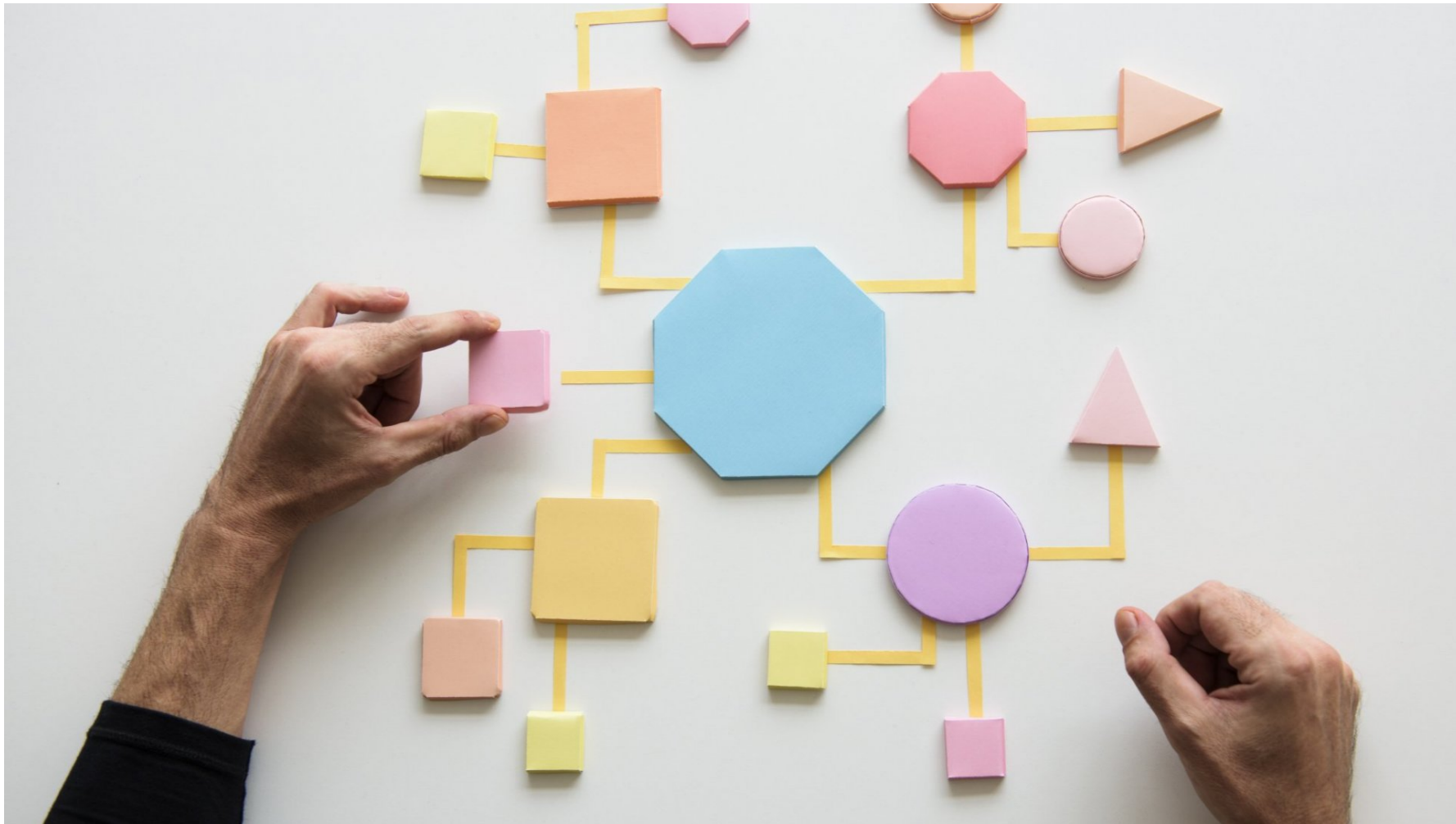

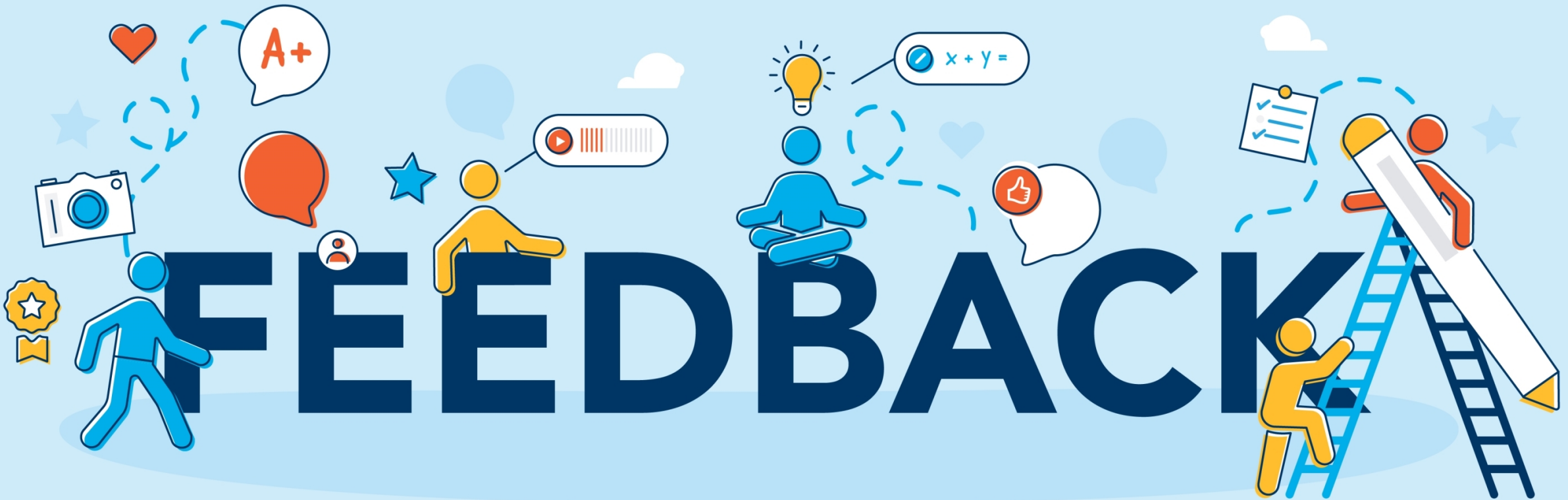

What is a Standard?

- A core standard is an articulation of the demonstrated proficiency to be obtained.
- A standard represents an essential element of the learning that is expected.



Standards vs. Curriculum

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What's the difference?

Standards

are the goals for instruction.

Standards are developed at the **state** level.

Curriculum

is the content of instruction.

Curricula are selected **locally**.



Standard to Curriculum

Standard

- Secondary Earth Science Standard 4.1
- Construct an explanation for how the availability of natural resources, the occurrence of natural hazards, and changes in climate affect human activity. Examples of natural resources could include access to fresh water, clean air, or regions of fertile soils.

Curriculum

Science in Context:

Recent events - Jackson, Mississippi has a lack of clean running tap water.

Potential Task - Evaluating the social and economic demographics of the city, to see the impact on the people of Jackson, MS.
