Call to Order

Chair Staggs called the meeting to order and called a roll call. Board Members Buroker, McDougal, and Pierucci were present. Board Members McCay and Wells were excused.

Discussion/Action Items

State Mandated Training

Ryan Carter, City Attorney, explained that Board Members are required to complete training for board members of service districts. He will follow up with an email.

Unified Fire Authority Presentation

Chief Wade Watkins presented the Unified Fire Authority presentation which is included in the packet.

Councilmember Buroker asked how the inspections are received by the businesses being inspected. Chief Watkins said the reception has been good. LIVE is the group of fire fighters who perform the company level inspections and these inspections are submitted directly to businesses electronically.

Councilmember Buroker asked for clarification on response for a one-house fire. Chief Watkins said that for a first alarm assignment on a single-family dwelling there are three Type 1 engines, a ladder truck, battalion chief, one medic ambulance and possibly a heavy rescue. Chief Watkins said for a multi-family dwelling or commercial occupancy, the response will be scaled up and as fast as it is scaled up, it will also be scaled down depending on the type of fire.

Councilmember Pierucci thanked him for his service.

RFSA Minute Approval: December 13, 2022

Board Member Buroker **MOVED** that the Riverton Fire Service Area Board approve the **RFSA Minutes for December 13, 2022**. Board Member McDougal **SECONDED** the motion. Chair Staggs called for discussion on the motion. There being none, he called for a roll-call vote. The vote was as follows: Buroker-yes, McDougal-yes, and Pierucci-yes.
