City of Orem Victim Services \$30,000, City of Orem Homeless Services \$1,896.90, City of Orem Code Enforcement \$161,500, Section 8 Loan Payment \$103,000, City of Orem CDBG Administration \$126,529.20, City of Orem Neighborhood Preservation \$30,000, Target Neighborhood Park signage \$64,321.25, City of Orem Critical Home Repair and Home Rehabilitation Program \$100,000, Rocky Mountain University Foundation \$20,000, Family Haven \$23,000, Kids on the Move \$10,000, Mountain Country Home Solutions \$30,000, and Community Health Connect \$10,000.
