Good of the Order	<p>School nurses will need to present the maturation programs for review.</p> <p>A revised maturation program can be used for Special Education students as long as the material is modified to fit the needs of the students, but not changed.</p> <p>Rates of STI's are climbing in Salt Lake County. Teachers feel there needs to be more education for students on the risks of Sexually Transmitted Infections. There is a presentation taught by Planned Parenthood that has been approved for school use.</p> <p>Teachers expressed concerned about support for Trans students and their families.</p>
