**THE TOWN OF ALTA'S PROPOSED STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY**  
**DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVE AND PROPOSED USE OF FUNDS**

The Town of Alta participates in the Community Development Block Grant Program administered by Salt Lake County. CDBG funds provided by the Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) are used for eligible projects, which benefit low and moderate income qualified areas in the Town of Alta. Projects must be designated to benefit either a majority of low and moderate income families or they must aid in the prevention of blight and deterioration.

It is being proposed by the Town of Alta that Community Development Block Grant Funds received by the Town for the 2014-2015 program years are earmarked for the following projects:

Of the estimated \$2,500 to be spent by the Town of Alta, \$2,500 or 100% will go to purchase new picnic tables at the Alta Town Park. Information regarding the past use of funds is available upon request, at no cost, at the Alta Town Office, Alta, Utah between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M.

The Alta Town Council will present the above recommendations at a public hearing on Thursday, April 10, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. at the Alta Community Center/Library. All written proposals received in the Town Office prior to this meeting will be discussed and all interested citizens will be given the opportunity to comment on the use of the Town's 2014-2015 CDBG funds. A final decision on the use of these funds will be made by the Alta Town Council following the public hearing.

The Alta community Center is not an accessible facility. Reasonable accommodations (including auxiliary communicative aids and services) for individuals with disabilities may be provided upon receipt of a request with three working days' notice.
