REVIEW TITLE 15A-3-201

The committee reviewed this section and discussed how it might apply to the NEC. Ross Ford asked the committee for a clarification and if the current amendments to the 2020 NEC should apply to the IRC. The committee agreed with his interpretation.

REVIEW PROPOSED AMEND-
MENTS TO 2021 IRC

Those present reviewed the amendments submitted by Ross Ford. The committee reviewed each proposal and the following recommendations were made. Ross Ford spoke on each proposal.

E3601.8

Ryan Jackson spoke to the committee in connection

with this proposal and spoke in opposition. Chris Jensen pointed out that if this section is deleted, there will be a cost increase for a remodel. He is also asking the committee to deny the proposal. Following the discussion on this proposal, a motion was made by Joseph Taft to deny the proposal. The motion was seconded by Willie Chidester and passed unanimously.

E3606.5. E3606.5.1, E3606.5.2,
E3606.5.3

The committee looked at this proposal to delete these sections. Ryan Jackson spoke to the committee and asked that they deny the proposal. Following further discussion, Ross Ford withdrew the request for the proposal based on the wording in Title 15A-3-201.

E3900

Ross Ford withdrew his request for this proposal based on the wording in Title 15A-3-201.

E3901.4.2

During the discussion on this section and the proposed amendment, Ryan Jackson pointed out that this section is being revised in the 2023 NEC. Chris Jensen volunteer to draft a proposal for this section to add the wording from the 2023 NEC. Following his recommendation, Ross Ford agreed to the revision of his proposal. Joseph Taft suggested that the committee also recommend that the same amendment be drafted for the NEC Article 210.52(C). Following the review of the revised proposal, a motion was made by Bryan Romney to approve the modified amendment for E3901.4.2, E3901.4.3 and also include a new amendment for the NEC Article 210.52(C). The motion was seconded by Joseph Taft and passed unanimously.

E3902.1 THROUGH E3902.12

During the review of this proposal, Ross Ford withdrew the request for an amendment.

Bryan Romney pointed out that the current amendment for Section E3901.4.5 should be looked at again. Following the review and discussion, a motion was made by Bryan Romney to delete the current amendment. The motion was seconded by Joseph Taft

Bryan Romney also pointed out that the current amendment for E3901.9, which a recommendation has been previously approved to change the number to E3703.5, needed to be reviewed a second time. A motion was made by Bryan Romney to delete the current amendment. The motion was seconded by Willie Chidester and passed unanimously.
