Levi Savage Jr. (March 23, 1820 – December 13, 1910) is a prominent figure in the history of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. He was one of the LDS Church's earliest missionaries to Asia and was one of the leaders of the Mormon pioneers traveling in the Willie Handcart Company. He moved from Kanab, Utah and lived the rest of his days in Toquerville as a farmer. He is buried in the Toquerville Cemetery.
