RESOLUTION 2023.XX DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS



A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE A SPECIFIC LOCATION AND TIMES TO DISCHARGE FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY REASONS.

WHEREAS, the Toquerville City Council recognizes the need to establish a criteria for discharging fireworks with in the city; and

WHEREAS, Southern Utah is experiencing severe drought conditions and extreme fire danger; and

WHEREAS, at the recommendation of the Hurricane Valley Fire District; and

WHEREAS, Utah State Law dictates specific times and dates class C fireworks shall be discharged; and

WHEREAS, the Toquerville City desires to notify citizens of the allowed location and specific times to discharge fireworks to preserve the general health, welfare, and fire safety of the community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Fireworks may only be discharged at the Trail Ridge Estates Park and Center Street Park the following dates and times:
 - a. July 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} , 5^{th} , 22^{nd} , 23^{rd} , and 25^{th} between the hours of 7 p.m. until 11 p.m.
 - b. July 4th and 24th between the hours of 7 p.m. until midnight.
- 2. No Aerial fireworks of any kind are permitted.
- 3. Any person who violates the restrictions in part one of this resolution, is guilty of an infraction per state code 53-7-225(4) Punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000.00.

THIS RESOLUTION shall repeal and supersede all prior resolutions governing fireworks discharge and become effective immediately upon approval and adoption by the Toquerville City Council.
