Mayor Justin Sip called the special city council meeting to order at 11:21 am.

Afton Moore gave a recap of 2022 and discussed calendar events.

A PowerPoint was presented by Candus Tibbetts with Hinton Burdick on a general fund overview and a breakdown of revenues and expenses.

Ty Bringhurst

Councilman Bringhurst commented on the bike racks at the parks, public works equipment, the parkway grand opening, Cholla Creek turning lanes and reconstruction, crack seal, as well as possibly starting a scholarship program.

Mayor Justin Sip

Mayor Sip shared his recommendations on having an amphitheater in Center Street Park, solar panels on top of our water tanks, the boulevard redesign, as well as Miss Toquerville prizes.

Todd Sands

Councilman Sands wants to make sure that the Cemetery is properly taken care of, connecting the city with trails, clean up the creeks, as well as consider raising the council members' wages.

Gary Chaves

Councilman Chaves agreed with all the comments that were already made but would also like to have a plan for the commercial businesses along the parkway and the adult community. He would also like to move signs making them more effective as well as addressing the complaints concerning out code enforcement.

Chuck Williams

Councilman Williams would like to have a theme throughout Toquerville.

Joey Campbell

Councilman Campbell shared his recommendations to put in a trail system that goes under the freeway connecting everything without stopping traffic.

Jadee Adams

Public Works Director Jadee Adams would like to look into moving the water meter at Center Street Park, as well as looking into the septic tank and a park redesign, along with replacing the siding on city buildings. He commented on the city storage issue and keeping the cemetery maintained. He suggested having a street sweeper come through the city twice a year.
