- Utah County is administering the “Vote by Mail” for Spanish Fork City 2023
- Utah County will create and mail all the ballots out
 - ballots are sent 3 to 1 week before the election
- Utah County will validate, process, and count all the returned ballots
- Utah County will charge the city (per registered voter)

1

Must be a US citizen and at least 18 years old

2

Registered voter in the municipality in which the individual is elected

3

Reside in the city for 12 consecutive months

4

Maintain a principal place of residence

5

If you were annexed into the city 12 consecutive months

6

Not convicted of a felony, treason, or crime relating to elections

7

Cannot of been declared mentally incompetent

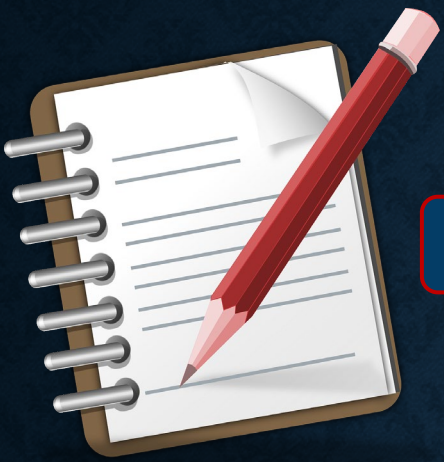

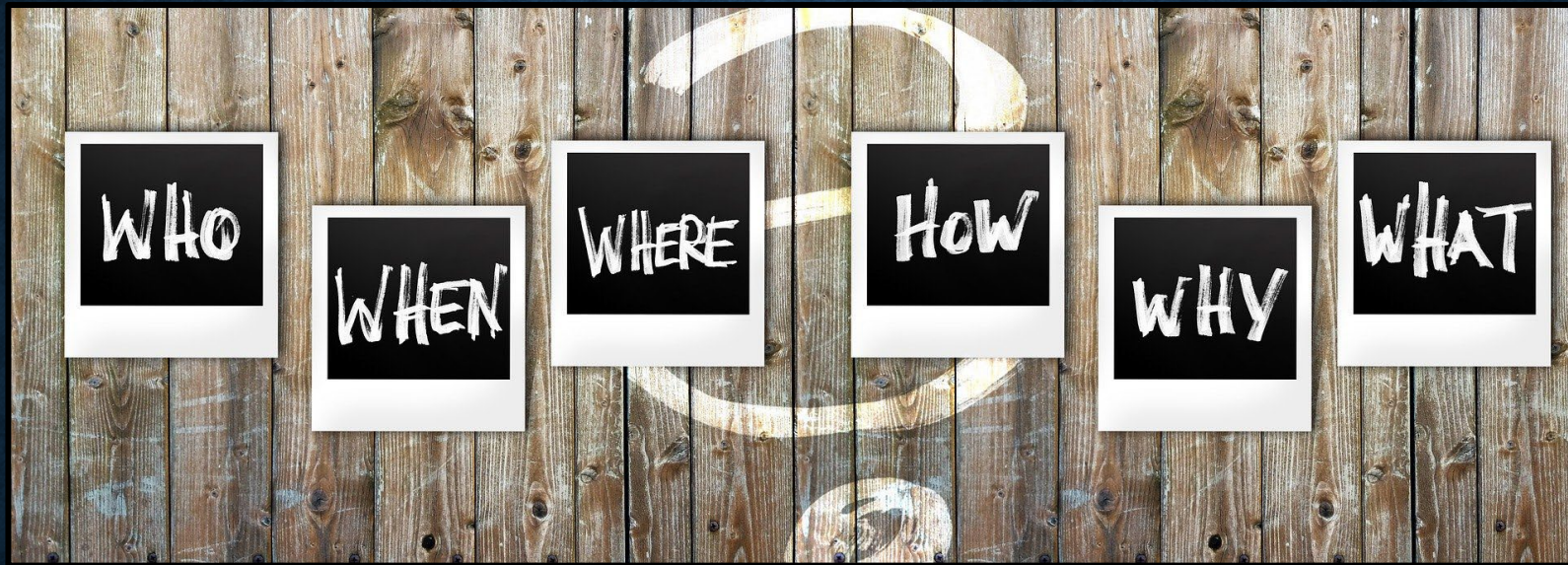
