**(1) Case No. 13-1129**

The Commission recommends suspension of the educator's Level 2 Secondary Education and Middle Education License in UPPAC Case No. 13-1129. The educator may request a reinstatement hearing following satisfaction of all conditions in the stipulated agreement and completion of a criminal background check, no sooner than six (6) months from the date of Board action. Any UPPAC recommendation for reinstatement following a hearing is subject to Board approval.

**(2) Case No. 13-1155**

The Commission recommends revocation of the educator's Level 2 Secondary Education License in UPPAC Case No. 13-1155. Under U.C.A. 53A-6-501(2)(a)(i), the Utah State Board of Education shall permanently revoke the educator license of an educator who engages in sexually explicit conduct as defined in the criminal code. The educator's conduct constitutes sexually explicit conduct under this definition.

**(3) Case No. 13-1132**

The Commission recommends suspension of the educator's Level 2 Elementary Education License in UPPAC Case No. 13-1132. The educator may request a reinstatement hearing following satisfaction of all conditions in the stipulated agreement and completion of a criminal background check, no sooner than four (4) years from the date of Board action. Any UPPAC recommendation for reinstatement following a hearing is subject to Board approval.

**(4) Case No. 13-1139**

The Commission recommends revocation of the educator's Level 1 Secondary Education License in UPPAC Case No. 13-1139. Under U.C.A. 53A-6-501(2)(a)(i), the Utah State Board of Education shall permanently revoke the educator license of an educator who engages in sexually explicit conduct as defined in the criminal code. The educator's conduct constitutes sexually explicit conduct under this definition.
