

Bulletin Board Policy

1. Purpose

- 1.1. The purpose for the bulletin board at the Uintah County Heritage Museum is to provide information to Museum visitors about local events.
- 1.2. Uintah County sponsored events shall take precedence over non-sponsored Uintah County events.
- 1.3. No other area in the Museum is an appropriate location for material distribution.

2. Conditions

- 2.1. Only displays for public events, rather than private events, will be allowed.
- 2.2. Public events include:
 - 2.2.1. information regarding civic, cultural, charitable, and/ or educational events in the area;
 - 2.2.2. notices from governmental agencies; and
 - 2.2.3. similar types of notices
- 2.3. Public notices do NOT include notices that convey personal opinion or are for private benefit, including but not limited to:
 - 2.3.1. For sale notifications;
 - 2.3.2. Business related notices such as business cards, advertising, and work wanted information;
 - 2.3.3. Lost and found notices.
- 2.4. Museum management is responsible for approving or disapproving items to be posted.
- 2.5. Items will be monitored and removed on a regular basis.
- 2.6. Individuals will not be informed when their notice is removed, and the posted notice will not be returned.
