SUMMARY

The federally funded HOPWA program grants funding to local communities, States, and nonprofit organizations for projects that benefit low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families. The State of Utah is a formula grantee that is awarded an annual allocation by the Federal Housing and Urban Development office for this purpose.

For State Fiscal Year 2024, the Office of Homeless Services was allocated \$342,050 to award to grantees who will provide housing and case management services to qualified households. The Request for Grant Proposal (RFGA) was opened on April 19, 2023. Applications were due on May 29, 2023 and four applications were received from three organizations. An allocation committee of community partners reviewed each application and provided funding recommendations.

All applications received were approved for funding. A breakdown of each application amount and a brief description of their project type is provided as Attachment D: HOPWA State Fiscal Year 2024 Awards Summary.
