FY24 Ask: \$56,102.57

FY24 Ask: \$228,270.39

FY24 Award: \$237,537.18

Project Description: Tenant Based Rental Assistance, which provides qualified households with rental subsidy along with case management supportive services.

Utah Community Action

FY24 Ask: \$33,506.00

FY24 Award: \$34,866.20

Project Description: Short-Term Rent, Mortgage, and Utility Assistance. A preventive housing intervention intended to reduce the risks of homelessness, and when utilized together with other HOPWA efforts (including access to health care services, case management, benefits counseling, and employment or vocational services) works to stabilize assisted households.

Utah Community Action

FY24 Ask: \$10,827.00

FY24 Award: \$11,266.53

Project Description: Permanent Housing Placement. An eligible supportive service activity under the HOPWA program, the goal of which is to help establish a permanent residence when continued occupancy is expected.
